

Display Board Checklist (55 points)

Visual presentation elements (30 points):

- visually attractive and relevant to the country
- the country's name placed in a central location
- picture of the country's flag
- world map with the country's location highlighted
- map of the country identifying
 - o capital
 - o major cities
 - o major geographical features (large mountains, lakes, rivers)
 - o bordering countries
 - o scale

Information presentations (20 points)

- graphics are used to display key statistics compared to the world data
- free of spelling errors
- easy to read and understand

Miscellaneous (5 points)

- essay displayed

Essay: Writing Checklist (45 points)

Format

- Sentences are clear.
- Sentences are grammatically correct.
- There are no spelling errors.
- Each paragraph begins with an appropriate topic sentence and has at least 5 complete sentences.
- Each paragraph focuses on a single topic that supports the main idea.
- At least 3 relevant sources are used and listed correctly on a bibliography.
- Paper is at minimum two-pages long.

Introduction

- Title reflects the topic of the essay.
- Main idea or argument is clearly stated.
- Key supporting points are outlined briefly.

Content addresses the following critical questions

- What is the problem facing your assigned country? And how does it relate to health?
- How does the problem affect the population of your country or whom does it affect?
- What are some underlying causes of the problem?
- What are some solutions for the problems? Are they effective short- or long-term solutions? Why or why not?
- Suggest a way in which you and others can make a difference in solving the problem.

Conclusion

- Main idea or argument is restated, but different from the Introduction.
- Main points are summarized in a paragraph.
- The significance of your topic is included—for example, why should people care?

Bibliography

- All sources are listed in correct format and in alphabetical order.
